

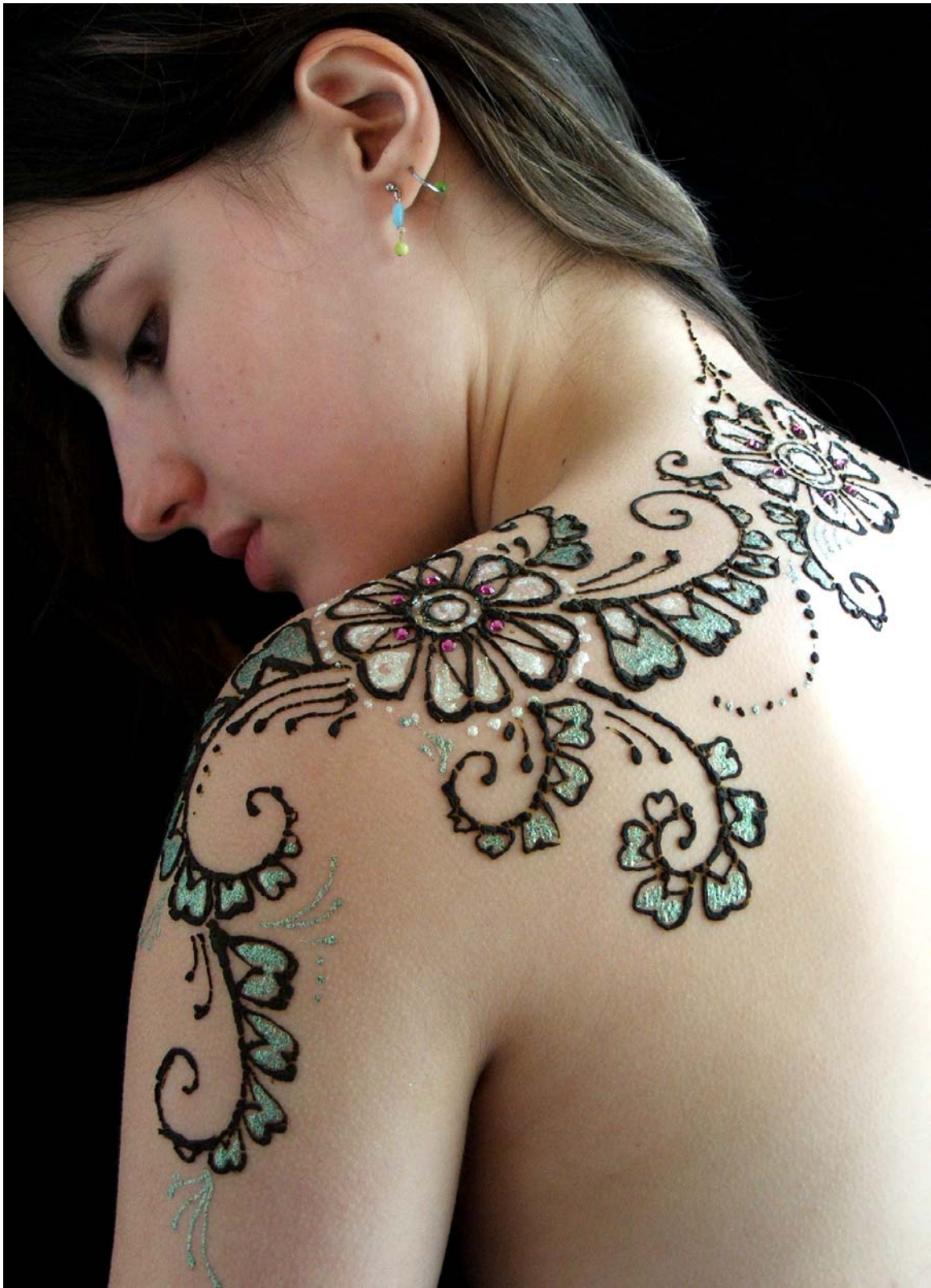
Foreword from the artist, Kim Brennan
